

RE: Current Certificates of Insurance

Dear Valued Supplier:

It is TriQuint's policy to work with companies who are properly insured. Please provide the following certificates for the line indicated:

- Contractor / Repair / Professional Service:** Provide Certificate of Insurance and maintain insurance for general liability with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 occurrence / \$2,000,000 aggregate, motor vehicle liability \$1,000,000 suggested, and workers compensation – statutory requirements, including employers liability. TriQuint Semiconductor, Inc. must be named as an **additional insured** on the Certificate of Insurance for general liability, and if possible, auto liability.
- Material Supplier/Vendor:** Provide Certificate of Insurance for general liability coverage with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 occurrence / \$2,000,000 aggregate. TriQuint Semiconductor, Inc. must be named as **additional insured** on the Certificate of Insurance.
- Design Professional:** Provide Certificate of Insurance for general liability with minimum limits of \$1,000,000. TriQuint Semiconductor, Inc. must be named as **additional insured** on the Certificate of Insurance. Professional liability coverage with minimum limits of \$1,000,000.
- IT Service Providers:** Provide Certificate of Insurance for general liability with minimum limits of \$1,000,000. TriQuint Semiconductor, Inc. must be named as **additional insured** on the Certificate of Insurance. Professional liability coverage with minimum limits of \$2,000,000/each claim or occurrence. Coverage should include for losses arising from breach of information security or cyber liability. Coverage can be under a professional liability or separate cyber liability policy.
